

Fickle Pickle Protocol: 2020

The Fickle Pickle Restaurant is one of RFAA's longest-running and most POPULAR venues. Because of the building's configuration, it is a challenge to hang each show. To ensure that All of our members have a fair opportunity to benefit from showing their work at this great venue, **PLEASE CAREFULLY READ AND COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES:**

CHANGE OUT DATES AT THE FICKLE PICKLE FOR 2020: all on Mondays from 4PM to 5PM

February 3

May 4

August 3

November 2

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS:

- MINIMUM of 8" x 10" to a MAXIMUM of 22" x 28" or any size in between
- All art on gallery wrapped canvases or in very lightweight frames and backings
- Wire hangers only: no saw tooth hangers
- NO glass or Plexiglas: the walls are too thin to carry much weight
- All artwork shown at RFAA Venues and Show must be dry before it is submitted NO wet or tacky pieces can be accepted.

ONLY REGISTERED ARTWORK WILL BE ACCEPTED

Submit a completely filled-out entry form (available under VENUES/FORMS at RFAA.ORG) and JPGs of artwork to Venue Chair, Donna Outwater. REGISTRATION BEGINS at 12:01AM on the Monday two weeks prior to the change out date. REGISTRATION ENDS AT 5PM on the Monday before the change out date. This allows for one week of registration.

TWO ENTRIES MAXIMUM PER ARTIST

- Registered artworks are accepted on the change out day on a first come, first served basis and must comply with size and venue requirements.
- The Venue Chair will accept registered art until all wall space is allotted. At that time, no more art will be accepted even when an application was submitted in writing before the registration deadline.
- If the total number of artworks accepted by the registration deadline is low, registered artists will be notified and invited to submit more.

SUBJECT MATTER: No theme, but the Restaurant Owner requests no portraits.

CHANGE OUT

- Artists will be notified which paintings to **bring to The Fickle Pickle, between 4PM and 5PM only on the change out dates.** Artists must sign in their new work, and a curator will sign out and return any previous work. Once art has been signed in and out, artists are requested to leave the premises promptly.
- Members may not hang their own work or choose a space. All art will be hung by designated helpers under the Venue Chair's supervision. The final decision to hang a work or not rests with the Venue Chair.
- The Restaurant Owner may decide to rearrange some pictures, so wait a couple of days before visiting to see the display. When you do visit, stay and enjoy some of the restaurant's great food!
