



FICKLE PICKLE PROTOCOL: Protocols as of November 2018

The Fickle Pickle Restaurant is one of RFAA's longest-running and most POPULAR venues. Because of the building's configuration, it is a challenge to hang each show. To ensure that ALL of our members have a fair opportunity to benefit from showing their work at this great venue,

PLEASE CAREFULLY READ AND COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES.

CHANGE OUT DATES FOR 2018 : all Mondays from 4PM to 5PM

February 5 May 7 August 6 November 5

ARTWORK SIZES:

MINIMUM 16"x20"

MAXIMUM 22"x28"

or any size in between.

All art should be on gallery wrapped canvases or in **very** lightweight frames, with **wire hangers only**: no sawtooth hangers. **NO glass or plexiglass**: the walls are too thin to carry much weight.

TWO ENTRIES per artist: if the total submitted is low, artists will be notified to submit more.

SUBJECT MATTER

There is no theme, but the restaurant owner requests **no art featuring people**.

ONLY PRE-REGISTERED PIECES WILL BE ACCEPTED

Please submit a **completely filled out entry form** (available under FORMS at RFAA.ORG) **and JPGs of artwork** to Mary Wyman **no later than the Monday before the change out date**.

Paintings are selected on a first come, first served basis, as well as the SIZE of works submitted. Curators will select at least one work submitted by each artist until all wall space is allotted. Artists will be notified what paintings to bring to The Fickle Pickle.

Artwork will be accepted **between 4PM and 5PM only** on the change-out dates. Artists must sign in their new work, and a curator will sign out and return any previous work. Once art has been signed in and out, artists are required to leave the premises.

Members may not hang their own work or choose a space. All art will be hung by designated helpers under venue chair Mary Wyman's supervision.

The owner may choose to rearrange some pictures, so artists are encouraged to wait a couple of days before visiting to see the display. When you do visit, stay and enjoy some of the restaurant's great food!
